



Supply Chain of Excellence Awards Evaluation Score Sheet

Below, please find a set of recommended criteria to keep in mind when evaluating Awards submissions.

SECTION 1:

- Provided the name of the submitting organization with background information.
- Clearly identified the challenge/problem that motivated change.
- Identified personnel, departments, suppliers, distributors or GPOs involved.
- Identified if this initiative can be replicated by other organizations, and specified the likely candidates for replication.

SECTION 2:

- Outlined initiative that was implemented and why it was selected.
- Stated start date of initiative and duration.
- Clearly described the initiative.
- Provided detail on implementation process.
- Described how those involved impacted the desired results.
- Identified who was involved in the review process, listing individual names and appropriate teams.

SECTION 3:

- Clearly identified challenges in the process.
- Explained in detail how challenges were addressed and resolved.

SECTION 4:

- Listed tangible results of initiative.
- Indicated the metrics used to measure progress and success.
- Documented and quantified cost and performance benefits, including the project's return on investment.
- Forecasted what future results are anticipated.
